Forma DJR revives Forma, the stylish sans serif released in 1968 by the renowned type foundry Nebiolo and created by a team of Italian designers led by the inimitable Aldo Novarese. Publications designer Roger Black has admired the design for years, so he commissioned DJR to revive it for his 2013 redesign of Hong Kong Tatler. Based on metal type found by Indra Kupferschmid, this interpretation captures the rounded corners, tapered stems, and subtle quirks that were byproducts of the printing process. With super-tight spacing in five optical sizes, this revival attempts to embody the peculiar collision of midcentury modernist precision and the smudgy realities of metal, ink, and paper.

David Jonathan Ross draws letters of all shapes and sizes for custom and retail typeface designs at his foundry DJR as well as for his Font of the Month Club.

Roger Black is a renowned publication designer, with decades of experience creating newspapers and magazines from *Rolling Stone* to *The Washington Post*.

Ruggero Magrì is an independent type designer and lettering artist from Italy. Both analog and digital, any potential application attracts and pushes him to explore new expressive possibilities.

Jovana Jocić is a freelance type designer based in Serbia focusing on multi-script typefaces, including Forma's upcoming Cyrillic.
